GAME HIGHLIGHTS

Pre-Season

On March 4th, in the 3rd inning the Majors Astro's Cooper Frost hit a line drive over the Majors left field fence for a 2-run home run to tie the game up. This was the first home run of the season for Frost. This was the first home run of the season for Sherman Oaks Little League. (3-6-2023) (#1)

Regular Season

- On March 16th, with his first pitch seen at SOLL in 8 months, the Majors Yankees' Nate Englander, hit a solo homerun beyond the CF fence. In the 4th inning, with 2 on and 2 out, Nate turned on a pitch and deposited the ball 50 feet onto the Soccer Fields past the LF foul pole for his 2nd home run. (3-16-2023) (#1 & #2)
- On March 18th, the Majors Dodgers' Landon May came up to the plate in the 6th inning with his team down 7-5. He hit a first-pitch fastball over the big blue wall on the AAA field for a walk-off three-run home run! This was Landon's first Majors home run of the season and first of his little league career. (3-18-2023) (#1)
- On March 18th, Legend Thomas hit a 2-run home run to left field in the 1st inning against the Yankees for the Tee Ball Kansas City Royals. This was the first home run in the Tee Ball Divisions, for the Tee Ball Royals and for Legend. In the same game, in the 3rd inning, he hit a grand slam to center field. This was the second home run of the season for Legend. (3-18-2023) (#1 & #2)
- On March 18th, in the bottom of the first inning, Devin-Jayce Moraleja hit a towering homerun over the center field fence on the AAA field. This was the first homerun of the season for the Minors division, the Minors Marlins and Moraleja. (3-18-2023) (#1)
- On March 18th, with the bases loaded in the bottom of the 3rd inning, Graham Anders of the Coach Pitch Cubs crushed a base clearing grand slam over the right field fence. This was Graham's first home run of the season. (3-18-2023) (#1)
- On March 19th, Nate Englander hit a 2-run HR to left field to open the scoring for the Yankees in the bottom of the 1st inning. In the bottom of the 6th, Nate hit his fourth homerun and first walk-off, a 3-run shot to Left field to seal the Yankees' 13-3 victory. (3-19-2023) (#3 & #4)
- On March 25th, Legend Thomas of the Tee Ball Kansas City Royals hit a 2-run homerun to center field against the Pirates. This was the third home run for Legend. (3-25-2023) (#3).
- On March 25th, the Majors Dodgers' Matt Kriegler hit the first pitch of the 3rd inning over the big blue wall on the AAA field. This was Matt's first Majors home run of the season and first of his little league career. (3-25-2023) (#1)

- On March 26th, the Majors Dodgers' Alison Hernandez hit a home run on the Majors field on a 0-2 count. This was Alison's first Majors home run of the season and first of her little league career. (3-26-2023) (#1)
- On March 28th, Nate Englander hit a 3-run HR with a line drive hit over the right field fence. (3-28-2023) (#5)
- On March 31st, in the 3rd inning on a 2-0 count, Cooper Frost of the Astros went opposite field, a dinger over the right field fence. This was the second four bagger of the season for Cooper. (3-31-2023) (#2)
- On April 1st, the Majors Yankees' Nate Englander hit a homerun in the first inning that was crushed over the right center fence on the AAA field. This was Nate's sixth homerun of the season. (4-1-2023) (#6)
- On April 1st, the Majors Cardinals' Grant Heyn hit a homerun shot over the AAA field scoreboard in center field. This was Grant's first homerun of the season. (4-1-2023) (#1)
- On April 1st, the Majors Dodgers' Alison Hernandez came up to bat in the 3rd inning with the bases loaded, two outs, and her team down 5-1. She hit a grand slam home run in the 3rd inning on the Majors field to tie up the game 5-5! This was Alison's second Majors home run of the season and second of her little league career. (4-01-2023) (#2)
- On April 5th, the Majors Rockies' Casey McDowell hit a 5th inning, 3 run line shot HR over the left center blue fence on the Major's Field to help the Rockies pull away from the Yankees in what had been a tight game. This was Casey's first regular season, over the fence Home Run at SOLL. (4-05-23) (#1)
- On April 6th, with the A's up 4-0 in the bottom of the 5th Tristan Jones hit a towering grand slam home run into left centerfield to make it 8-0. This was Tristan's first homerun of the season. (4-06-23) (#1)
- On April 8th, playing in only his third game of the season for the T-Ball Pirates Eli Berlinski saw a Tee he liked and hit a grand slam over the right field fence. This was Eli's first homerun of the season. (4-08-23) (#1)
- On April 8th, Troy Najarian of the Majors Padres hit a ball over the fence in right center field that went out of the park and onto the soccer fields in back of the Majors field. This was Troy's first homerun of the 2023 season and his second at the Majors level. (4-08-23) (#1)
- On April 8th, the Majors A's Tristan Jones came up in the bottom of the 5th inning with one runner on base and the team down 11-9 and launched 2 run homerun to tie the game for the A's who were down at one point 11-2. This was the second homerun of the season for Tristan. (4-08-23) (#2)
- On April 8th, the Majors Astros' Cooper Frost had a two home run day. He smoked a liner to the opposite side in a call over game for the Giants and smoked another 2run moonshot to left-center over the AAA Blue Monster for the Astros in the following game. These were Cooper's third and fourth Home Runs of the season. (4-08-23) (#3 & #4)

- On April 8th, the Majors Yankees' Nate Englander hit a homerun in the first inning over the right center fence on the AAA field. In Nate's next at bat he hit one over the left center Blue Monster on the AAA field. These were Nate's seventh and eighth homeruns of the season. (4-8-2023) (#7 & #8)
- On April 8th, Stevie Hernandez of the Minors Braves hit a homerun in the first inning. This was Stevie's first homerun of the season. (4-8-2023) (#1)
- On April 10th, Nate Englander hit a line drive home run over right center in the first inning. This was Nate's ninth homerun of the season. (4-10-2023) (#9)
- On April 10th, Sebastian Stevens of the Coach Pitch Tigers hit a HUGE bomb over the left field fence and into the central batting cages by 10 feet. This was Sebastian's first home run of the season and the first home run for the Coach Pitch Division. (4-10-2023) (#1)
- On April 15th, Nate Englander hit a ball over the Blue Monster's scoreboard in the 3rd inning for a 3-run homerun. This was Nate's 10th homerun of the season. (4-15-2023) (#10)
- On April 15th, aka Jackie Robinson Day, Legend Thomas of the T-Ball Royals slammed his 4th home run of the year. It was a 2-run homer to left field. (4-15-2023) (#4)
- On April 19th, Cooper Frost of the Majors' Astros went yard with a solo shot to right center on the Major's field. This was Copper's 5th home run deposit of the season. (4-19-2023) (#5)
- On April 21st, the Majors Yankees' Nate Englander hit his 11th homerun, a 3 run fly ball to left field in the 3rd inning. (4-22-2023) (#11)
- On April 22nd, Nate Englander went oppo with a 2-run homerun in the bottom of the 6th to help rally the Yankees from a 6-3 deficit. This was Nate's 12th home run of the season. (4-22-2023) (#12)
- On April 22nd, Cooper Frost of the Majors' Astros rocked a 2-run blast over the center field fence of the Major's field. This was Copper's 6th home run of the season. (4-22-2023) (#6)
- On April 22nd, Rylan Howard of the Majors' Red Sox led off the top of the third with a "Stantonian" bullet line drive solo home run to dead center to put the Red Sox ahead 3-0. This was Rylan's 1st home run of the season. (4-22-2023) (#1)
- On April 22nd, in the second inning, the Majors' Rockies Miles Pointer hit line shot over the right center field fence on the AAA Field for a 2-run Home Run in the Rockies win. It was Miles' first "over the fence" Home Run of his SOLL career. (4-22-2023) (#1)
- On April 22nd, on the first pitch he saw in the 3rd inning, Casey McDowell of the Majors Rockies hit a towering 3-run Home Run over the Blue Monster and over the trees in left field on the AAA Field. It was Casey's 2nd Home Run of the season. (4-22-2023) (#2)

- On April 22nd, the Majors Dodgers' Landon May hit a two-run home run in the first inning. This was Landon's second Majors home run of the season and the second of his career. (4-22-2023) (#2)
- On April 22nd, the Majors Phillies' Roman James, playing in a call over game for the Padres, hit a home run in the 4th inning over the Blue Monster to left center on the AAA field. This was Roman's first home run of the season. (4-22-2023) (#1)
- On April 22nd, Jair Galeano of the Red Sox in the Tee Ball division hit his, and the teams, first-ever home run! In his first at-bat of the game he launched the ball from the tee over the right field fence, landing on one of "the big kids" fields, where a player kindly returned the ball that now adorns a shelf in Jair's home! (4-22-2023) (#1)
- On April 25th, Cooper Frost of the Majors' Astros punched out another 2-run bomb over the left center field fence on the Major's field. This was Coops 7th home run of the season. (4-25-2023) (#7)

- On April 27th, the Majors' Cardinals Ethan Glazer launched a shot way over the Blue Monster in left field of the AAA field. This was Ethan's first home run of the season.
- On April 27th, Legend Thomas of the T-ball Royals hit a solo lead off home run in the first inning over the left field fence, then came back up in the 2nd inning and hit another solo home run over the left field fence. These were the sixth and seventh home runs for Legend. (4-27-2023) (#6 & #7).
- On April 29th, in the first inning on his first at bat of the game, Jackson Converse of the Coach Pitch Giants, stepped up to the plate with a mission....that mission was to get a great hit to start the game. Jackson took the first pitch and as the second pitch came he locked in and swung.....The second you heard the contact everyone knew it was a great hit. Exit velocity was high and the ball was headed straight out to center field and like we all knew that ball wasn't coming back that day. Jackson hit the safety fence in the outfield above the blue wall for the first home run of the season for our team and the first home run of his baseball career. (4-29-2023) (#1)
- On April 30th, Legend Thomas of the T-ball Royals hit a Grand Slam home run deep over the left field fence in the 2nd inning. This was the eight home run for Legend. (4-30-2023) (#8).

Post Season

- On May 8th, Devin-Jayce Moraleja of the Minors Marlins hit a 2-run home run over the right field fence on majors for the first home run of Sherman Oak's Little League playoff season. This was the third home run of the season for Devin-Jayce and the Minors Marlins. (5-9-2023) (#3)
- On May 13th, Abe Guerrero #5 for the T-Ball Yankees hit his first home-run of the season. His home-run was a line drive over the center field fence! (5-13-2023) (#1)
- On May 13th, Legend Thomas of the T-Ball Royals hit a 3-run homer over the left field wall in the 4th inning. This was the 9th home run of the season for Legend. (5-13-2023) (#9)
- On May 13th, Theodore Reid of the T-Ball Kansas City Royals, hit two home runs. - On May 13th, Jair Galeano of the Red Sox in the Tee Ball division hit his fourth home run of the season with a blast off his bat that soared over the right centerfield fence as he continues to stay hot at the plate. (5-13-2023) (#4)
- On May 13th, Angelo Barrera of the Red Sox in the Tee Ball division hit his second home run of the season, crushing the ball deep over the right centerfield fence as he continues to become a powerful slugger. (5-13-2023) (#2)
- On May 13th, in the first inning with bases loaded, Emmett Medill of the Coach Pitch Giants, stepped up to the plate batting 5th for the inning...Emmett does his traditional double tap of the bat on the plate, gets his feet set and waits for the pitch. Without blinking Emmett takes the first pitch yard and hits a rocket over the left field wall just on the fair side of the foul pole. IN true fashion Emmett stands there watching to make sure it was out before running to first. This marks the home run #1 of the season for Emmett and Grand Slam #1 of Emmett's baseball career! (5-13-2023) (#1)
- On May 13th, Demian Gnilevskii of the Tee Ball Cardinals hit a sky-high 3-run home run over center field at the tee ball field. This was Demian's first home run of the season and his SOLL career! (5-13-2023) (#1)
- On May 15th, Stevie Hernandez of the Minors Braves a solo home run in the 4th inning. This was Stevie's third home run of the season. (5-15-2023) (#3)
- On May 18th, Nate Englander hit a 2-0 pitch in the dirt over the Majors' Left Field fence to increase the Yankees' lead. This was Nate's first postseason Homerun and the 16th on the year. (5-18-2023) (#16)
- On May 20th, Legend Thomas of the Kansas City Royals in Tee Ball, hit a 3-run homer to left center field which gives him 10 homers for the season with 2 games left. (5-20-2023) (#10)
- On May 20th, in the 2nd inning the Coach Pitch Tigers' Sebastian Stevens hit a sky high moon shot over left center field for his league leading 2nd home run of the year. (5-20-2023) (#2)
- On May 20th, in the 3rd inning the Coach Pitch Tigers' Knox Hains smashed a grand slam that almost cleared the first batting cage in left center field for his first home run of the season and first career SOLL home run. (5-20-2023) (#1)
- On May 20th, Noah McGinnis of the T-Ball Pirates stepped to the plate with one on in the second inning. McGinnis, who has been pelting the fence since his days in wee ball finally saw a tee he liked and crushed a ball over the right field fence. It was the first home run of the season and career for the young slugger. (5-20-2023) (#1)
- On May 20th, Jair Galeano of the Red Sox in the Tee Ball division hit his fifth and sixth home runs of the season as his hot streak continues, sending both homers deep over the right field fence with power and a big smile! (5-20-2023) (#5 & #6)

- On May 20th, Caden Humphries, of the Kansas City Royals in Tee Ball, hit 2 home runs. These were Caden's first and second home runs of the season. (5-20-2023) (#1 & #2)
- On May 20th, as the leadoff hitter at the top of the 3rd inning, Emmett Medill of the Coach Pitch Giants walked up to the plate ready for whatever pitch he might get. As the first pitch flew by for a strike, Emmett settled in, reset his feet, did his traditional 2 plate taps and locked in for the pitch. The second pitch left Emmett's bat twice as fast as it came in flying well over the left center fence over and beyond the GB soccer banner that hangs from the fence in that area. This was Emmet's second home run of the season. (5-20-2023) (#2)
- On May 20th, Brendan Eckstein of the Coach Pitch Cubs, hit a line drive over the left center field wall to round the bases. This was Brendan's first home run of the season. (5-20-2023) (#1)
- On May 21st, in a make-up game, Jair Galeano of the Red Sox in the Tee Ball division hit his seventh home run of the season with a laser beam line drive to right field that had opposing coaches ducking for cover! (5-20-2023) (#7)
- On May 22nd, Legend Thomas, of the Kansas City Royals in Tee Ball, hit 3 home runs. (5-22-2023) (#11, #12 & #13)
- On May 22nd, Caden Humphries, of the Kansas City Royals in Tee Ball, hit 3 home runs. These were Caden's third, fourth and fifth home runs of the season. (5-22-2023) (#3, #4 & #5)
- On May 23rd, Jair Galeano of the Red Sox in the Tee Ball division hit his eighth home run of the season with a hard hit bomb over the wall in right. (5-23-2023) (#8)
- On May 30th, in the last game of the season, Legend Thomas, of the Kansas City Royals in Tee Ball, hit a grand slam home run in the 2nd inning over the left field fence for his 14th home run of the season. Then in the 3rd inning, he hit a towering home run over the center field fence and also over the AA fence onto the AA field for his 15th home run of the season. (5-30-2023) (#14 & #15)
