## GAME HIGHLIGHTS

### **Pre-Season**

- On March 14, River Kelly of the Tee Ball Guardians hit a homerun to right-center field.
- On Match 14, Miles Leavitt from the Tee Ball Orioles left the yard with a moonshot that sailed over the right center wall against the Pirates.
- On March 14, Owen Cooper of the Tee Ball Pirates hit a high fly ball to left field, clearing the wall.
- On March 14, Vincent Santoro of the Tee Ball Pirates hit a towering home run to dead center field.
