GAME HIGHLIGHTS



Pre-Season

Regular Season

- On February 28, Milo Ferenczi of the Tee Ball Royals went 15 yards over the right field wall.
- On March 7, Leo Jordan of the Tee Ball Pirates hit a ball to deep left center field that cleared the fence.
- On March 7, Milo Ferenczi of the Tee Ball Royals hit a liner just over the center field wall.
- On March 9, Lucas Schliebe of the Majors Braves hit a shot over the left field fence.
- On March 14, Easton Strauss of the Coach Pitch Yankees hit a big shot deep left center that hit the batting cage net during his game against the As.
- On March 14, River Kelly of the Tee Ball Guardians hit a homerun to right-center field.
- On March 14, Miles Leavitt from the Tee Ball Orioles left the yard with a moonshot that sailed over the right center wall against the Pirates.



- On March 14, Owen Cooper of the Tee Ball Pirates hit a high fly ball to left field, clearing the wall.
- On March 14, Vincent Santoro of the Tee Ball Pirates hit a towering home run to dead center field.
- On March 14, as a call over for the Majors Athletics, London Huddleston hit a home run over the centerfield wall.
- Micah Sullivan of the Tee Ball Phillies, who hit lead off on March 14, hit a home run on the 1st swing of the game. He did it again on his 2nd swing and it took him just one more swing for his third home run of the game. He went 3-3 with three home runs, all over the left field fence.
- On March 18, Jack Ryan of the Majors Reds led off the game against the Mariners with a towering home run over the left field fence. The monster shot set the tone for the Reds who went on to win a close game.
- On March 20, Owen Williams of the Minors Dodgers hit a walk off solo home run.
- On March 21, Vincent Santoro of the Tee Ball Yankees hit a home run to right center field.
- On March 21, Carter Hilvert of the Majors A's hit a home run against the Braves.
- On March 25, Declan Alderman of the Majors Diamondbacks hit a prodigious blast to left center field. The ball cleared the back fence by about 15 feet.
- On March 27, Branden Arciniega of the Majors White Sox hit a towering home run over the right field fence vs. the Yankees on the Majors field.
- On March 28, Devan Mattoo of the Majors Yankees hit his third home run to deep center field in the bottom of the first inning on AAA.
- Later that game, Devan Mattoo of the Majors Yankees again hit a home run, his second of the game and fourth of the year, in the bottom of the 5th with a runner on base.
- Beckett Maillard of the Majors Diamondbacks hit an absolute laser on March 28. The ball, hit to left centerfield, cleared both fences...for a GRAND SLAM!



- On March 28, Teddy Leonard of the Coach Pitch Yankees hit a big show over the wall in left center against the Blue Jays and the ball almost reached the AA field.
- On March 28, Bryant Bermudez of the Majors Rays blasted a solo shot to left center over the big blue wall on AAA.
- On March 28, the Tee Ball Cardinals hit three home runs in one game, two by Max Zegarra. Max's first home run was a laser just to the right of centerfield. Later in the game Max blasted a second home run that easily cleared the wall in centerfield. Then Joshie Graber, a sweet swinging left, crushed a ball to dead right field that easily cleared the outfield fence.
- On March 28, Ryder Coronella of the Tee Ball Phillies hit a left field fence home run in his second at bat.
- On April 4, Jay Rachakanda of the Tee Ball White Sox blasted a home run.
- On April 4, Teddy Leonard, Sonny Marell and Wolf Odell of Larry Manis's Coach Pitch Yankees all hit home runs. Teddy hit one to the top of the batting cages and Sonny and Wolf both his monster shots to dead center over the wall.
- On April 4, Vincent Santoro of the Tee Ball Pirates hit a line drive home run over the right field wall.
- On April 4, Roman Lankford of the Coach Pitch Nationals hit a ball over the centerfield fence in the first inning of the Nationals' game against the Rays.
- On April 4, Chloe Greenberg of the Tee Ball Royals blasted a line drive over the center field wall. The ball cleared the wall by 20 feet.
- On April 4, Thomas Hale of the Tee Ball Cardinals scorched the ball to dead center field, and it hit the yellow coping at the top of the fence and bounced straight into the air. Thankfully it still had enough momentum to land cleanly on the other side.
- On April 4, Declan Alderman of the Majors Diamondbacks hit his second home run of the year, a three-run blast over the right-centerfield wall against the White Sox on the Majors field.



- On April 7, London Huddleston of the Majors Orioles blasted the first pitch he saw clear over both fences in right center. It was a scorching line drive to opposite field that was gone as soon as it left his bat.
- On April 11, Vincent Santoro of the Tee Ball Pirates hit a home run over the right field fence for a 3 run blast.
- On April 11, Ryder Coronella of the Tee Ball Phillies hit his second home run of the season, a dead center field bomb that cleared the fence by about 30 feet in his second at bat.
- On April 15, Elliott Rosenzweig of the Majors Orioles stepped up to the plate in the top of the 5th inning with runners on 2nd and 3rd. On an 0-1 count, Elliott blasted a fastball high and deep to left field, clearing both fences for a 3 run bomb.
- On April 16, Declan Alderman of the Majors Diamondbacks hit a majestic flyball to right-centerfield that carried and carried and carried over both fences for this third bomb of the season.
- On April 18, Ethan Ajijola of the Coach Pitch Athletics hit two home runs, including a leadoff home run down the left field line hitting the foul pole and another home run deep over the centerfield wall in the second inning.
- On April 18, Liv Nassour of the Coach Pitch Nationals hit a ball deep over the left field fence between the batting cages.
- On April 18, Lucca Perron of the Tee Ball White Sox hit two bombs clean over the centerfield wall against the Pirates.
- On April 18, Milo Ferenczi of the Tee ball Royals hit two home runs, one that was a liner over the centerfield fence and one over the right field fence.
- On April 18, Chloe Greenberg of the Tee Ball Royals hit a liner over the centerfield wall.
- The April 18 Tee Ball game between the Phillies and Pirates featured many home runs. Ben Levey of the Phillies hit two home runs, including an absolute rope over the left field wall in his first at bat and then again in his third bat. Phillies Micah Sullivan also hit a towering home run over the left field fence and Ryder Coronella also hit home runs over the left field fence. For the Pirates, Leo Jordan led off the game with a high fly ball that sailed over the centerfield wall. Leo's teammates Connell Kent and Vincent Santoro each had two home runs each. Connell hit a home run to rightcenter and later a no doubter to



center! Vincent Santoro smoked a line drive over the right field wall and then another line drive to left center that cleared the fence. Vincent and Connell went back to back. The Phillies had a 6th home run in the game, a high fly ball over the centerfield wall for a GRAND SLAM!

- On April 18, River Kelly of the Tee Ball Guardians hit two home runs, both to center field.
- On April 18 Lucas Schiebe of the Majors Braves hit a shot over the left center fence on the AAA field.
- On April 22, Lefty Joshie Garber of the Tee Ball Cardinals smashed a ball to right center that bounced off the AA left field pole about two feet above the fence.
- On April 22, Jack Ryan of the Majors Reds hit a solo rocket over the leftfield wall.
- On April 25, Ethan Ajjjola of the Coach Pitch Athletics hit a home run over the left centerfield fence in the 3rd inning. This is his third home run of the season.
- On April 25, Roman Lankford of the Coach Pitch Nationals went 2-2 with two home runs. Both homeruns were absolute bombs on to the batting cages.
- On April 25, Beckett Maillard of the Majors Diamondbacks hit an absolute bomb of a solo home runs to dead center on the AAA field. It was a line drive hit, and Beckett could tell it was out the moment it hit his bat on a 1-1 count.
- On April 25, Lucca Perron of the Tee Ball White Sox hit one over the center field wall during a game against the Rockies. ‘
- On April 25, the Tee Ball Pirates had three home runs. Leo Jordan his a no-doubt leadoff jack in the bottom of the first inning, Connell Kent ripped one that ricocheted off the top of the foul pole and Vincent Santoro hit a line-drive home run over the right center fence.
- On April 25, Tony Lin of the Tee Ball Guardians hit a home run to center field.
- On April 25, Ryder Coronella of the Tee Ball Phillies ripped a laser missile over the centerfield wall in his 3rd and final at bat of the game!
- On April 25, River Kelly of the Tee Ball Guardians hit a home run to center field.



- On April 25, Lucas Tyrrell of the Coach Pitch White Sox pulled the ball to left field over the foul pole.
- On May 1, Diego Godinez of the Majors Mariners hit a home run against the Majors Yankees that was a thing of beauty...
- On May 2, Teddy Leonard, Sonny Marell and Miles Cohen all hit home runs for the Coach Pitch Yankees.
- On May 2, Ethan Ajijola of the Coach Pitch Athletics hit his 4th home run of the season to deep centerfield in the third inning. He has hit home runs in 3 straight games.
- On May 2, Evan Soto from the Majors Phillies hit a 2-run shot in the top of the second. The ball went to dead center and hit the scoreboard on the Majors field.
- On May 2, Julian Rubo hit a home run to right center field for the Majors Cardinals.
- For the Tee Ball Rockies, Hank Sloan has hit 3 home runs and Nathan Ulyshen has hit 4 home runs. Together the teammates have hit 7 over the fence!
- On May 2, Walker Mishlof crushed his first home run of the year to straight away center and cleared the double high fence with room to spare! Walker has been recovering from a broken elbow this spring and is rounding into form just in time for the stretch run.
- On May 2, Connell Kent of the Tee Ball Pirates hit a deep drive to right center field that soared over the wall.
- On May 2, Joshie Graber of the Tee Ball Cardinals smashed yet another ball to right center that punishes the AA field foul pole. His second home run off the pole this year.
- On May 2, Ryder Coronella of the Tee Ball Phillies smoked a laser beam over the left centerfield wall in his first at bat. His teammate, Ben Leavey, also hit a home run on the first at bat of the game – a towering bomb over the left field wall.
- On May 2, in the first inning against the Majors Rays, Miles Kalina took one deep over the right field fence to put the A's on the board early.
- On May 7, Pablo Manning of the Majors Phillies crushed a two-run homer over the Blue Monster on AAA to give his team a 5-1 lead to take into the 6th.



- On May 9, Niko Garunts of the Coach Pitch Braves hit a deep shot over the fence in left center. The ball landed on top of the cages.
- On May 9, Ethan Ajijola of the Coach Pitch A's hit his 5th home run of the season deep centerfield in the second inning. Ethan has hit a home run in four straight games for the As.
- On May 9, Wyatt Deromedi of the Coach Pitch Angels and hitting 3rd in the lineup crushed a bomb to deep center field against the Mets.
- On May 9, Lucas Tyrrell of the Coach Pitch White Sox hit two home runs. One was a line drive over the left field wall into the batting cage and the other was a moon shot over the left field foul pole that landed on top of the batting cage.
- On May 9, there were four home runs for the Tee Ball Phillies. Ryder Coronella hit a moonshot over the left field wall in his first at bat, a bomb! Ben Levey hit a towering homerun on his first at bat of the game as well as his last at bat of the game. Another two towering home runs over the left field wall. Micah Sullivan ripped an impressive homerun in his second at bat of the game, a no doubter over the left field wall.
- On May 9, Issabella Mendoza of the Tee Ball Royals hit a line drive about 20 feet over the centerfield fence.
- Adrian Ramirez of the Tee Ball Mets has hit 3 home runs on the year, on April 11, April 25 and May 9!
- On May 9, Max Zegarra of the Tee Bill Cardinals hit a laser just to the right of centerfield. It was nearly identical to his first home run of the season.
- On May 9, the Tee Ball Pirates had SIX home runs, 2 by Vincent Santoro, 2 by Owen Cooper and one each by Connell Kent and Leo Jordan.
- On May 9, Teddy Leonard and Leo Kvamme of the Coach Pitch Yankees hit home runs. Teddy hit a towering shot over the left field wall and Leo hit a bomb over the right field wall.
- On May 9, the Tee Ball Guardians had three home runs: two by Tony Lin to right center field and one by River Kelly to right center field.



- On May 12, Branden Arciniega of the Majors White Sox hit a monster home run to right in the 5th inning of a tight playoff game.
- On May 13, Sam Kreitenberg of the Majors Orioles hit a playoff bomb to left field.
- On May 13, Declan Alderman of the Majors Diamondbacks hit TWO playoff bombs. In the first inning he hit a lead off home run, a laser to leftfield. The second shot was a rocket to left center that cleared both fences.
- On May 16, the Tee Ball Rockies had four home runs: Nathan Ulyshen went three for three home runs and Mylo Limonick hit his first home run at his last at bat of the season.
- On May 16, the Coach Pitch Yankees had two home runs vs. the White Sox: one by Teddy Leonard and one by Wolf Orell.
- On May 16, Rhys Rutherford of the Coach Pitch Marlins, with a pitch with decent pace over the outside part of the plate, rocketed the ball over the right field wall, clearing the wall by at least 20-30 feet.
- On May 16, the Tee Ball Phillies had five homeruns: Ryder Coronella had an absolute rope over the left field fence in his 2nd at bat. In his 3rd and final at bat of the season, Ryder hit a laser beam over the left field fence. Ben Levey hit the longest homerun of the season for the Phillies in his first at bat. He hit another bomb in his 2nd at bat, and stepped up in his 3rd and final at bat of the season and hit one last bomb over the left field wall. This was his 6th homerun in his final nine at bats of the season.
- On May 16, the Coach Pitch Nationals had two home runs: one by Liv Nassour, smashing one into the batting cages in a hurry, and one monster hit by Graham Gerhardt.
- On May 16, Benjamin Ogren of the Coach Pitch A's hit two home runs. Benjamin's first came in the first inning with a moon shot over the left field wall. The second was a line drive down the left field line in the second inning.
- On May 16, the Tee Ball Cardinals had SIX home runs in the final game of the season, 2 each by 3 different players: Max Zegarra, Joshie Graber and Owen Lacasse. Max hit two line drives to dead center field with both never traveling more than a few feet higher than the outfield fence. Joshie hit a tape measure shot to right field as well as a shot that may have gone OVER the AA field foul pole. After hitting half a dozen ground rule doubles through the season, Owen mastered the art of the backspin and hit two separate towering fly calls clearing the centerfield fence for his first two home runs.



- On May 16, Own Cooper of the Tee Ball Pirates hit a high fly ball that flew high above the centerfield wall.
- On May 16, Issabella Mendoza of the Tee Ball Royals hit a line drive CF shot 20 feet over the fence.
- On May 16, the Tee Ball Guardians had 3 home runs, including 2 by River Kelly and one by Tony Lin, all to rightcenter field.
- On May 16, Miles Leavitt of the Tee Ball Orioles hit a 2nd inning home run over the centerfield wall.
- On May 19, Abraham Guerrero of the AA Pirates hit a two-run homer in late a playoff game to dead center field. It was half was up the fence backstop protecting the coach pitch field. It was an absolute playoff bomb!
